ITINERARY

Sun 5 May 2019 Arrive London (D)
Check into your 4* Hotel in the afternoon before meeting your Hosts for a **Welcome Dinner**, accompanied by an informal concert with the Watts and their invited guests.

Mon 6 May 2019 London (B)
After breakfast in our hotel, we have an informative talk from our hosts on the days proceedings before we embark on a guided **City Sights** walking tour of London. *Optional Extra:* Join the Watts for dinner and a concert by the Canal at the vibrant new Kings Place concert hall (own account).

Tue 7 May 2019 London (B,D)
Enjoy a hearty breakfast - Bloomsbury beckons! Retrace the footsteps of Karl Marx, Virginia Woolf, Charles Darwin and the Pankhurst sisters. Then immerse yourself in the music of Handel, Purcell and Schubert at the **British Library and Foundling Museum**.
Tonight we dine together before heading to Covent Garden Opera House for Britten's **"Billy Budd"**.

Wed 8 May 2019 London (B,D)
The day begins with an informative morning music session with your Hosts, before visiting **Handel House**. This evening we have dinner at a local restaurant, and then attend a performance of **Elgar's "Dream of Gerontius"** at the Festival Hall.

Thu 9 May 2019 London (B)
Enjoy a leisurely morning free of structured arrangements, before a lunchtime concert at **St John's Smith Square** (dependent on concert schedules). This afternoon we head to **Westminster Abbey** for a personal Verger's tour, followed by evensong at 5pm.

Fri 10 May 2019 London-Oxford-Bath (B)
Check out of the hotel and travel by private executive coach to Oxford. Enjoy a guided tour of key sights in this stunning University town, including the **Bridge of Sighs**. We visit **Christ Church College**; the **Bodleian Library** and the **Bate Collection of Musical Instruments**. Continue to Bath this evening.

Sat 11 May 2019 Bath (B)
Let historic Bath share its secrets on a guided walking tour as we discover 18th-century Georgian architecture, natural hot springs and a remarkable collection of museums and galleries. You have time to relax and enjoy your surroundings this afternoon. This evening is at leisure, perhaps attend a concert or dine in one of Bath's many restaurants.

Sun 12 May 2019 Bath-London (B)

Tue 14 May 2019 London (B)
All aboard for the train to **Hampton Court Palace** where we spend the morning exploring the life of Henry VIII. This afternoon we visit **Leighton House Museum**, home to a remarkable collection of paintings and sculptures.
This evening is free of structured arrangements - you may wish to head to a West End show or attend the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment at the Festival Hall.

Wed 15 May 2019 London (B,D)
After breakfast we depart on the Underground for an eye-opening visit to the appetising **Borough Market**. After taste-testing our way around this foodie institution we take a short stroll to **The Shard** for some stunning views over the city from the highest indoor viewing platform in London. **Southwark Cathedral** awaits - we enjoy a guided tour. Tonight we celebrate many memorable moments together with a **Farewell Dinner** at a local restaurant.
